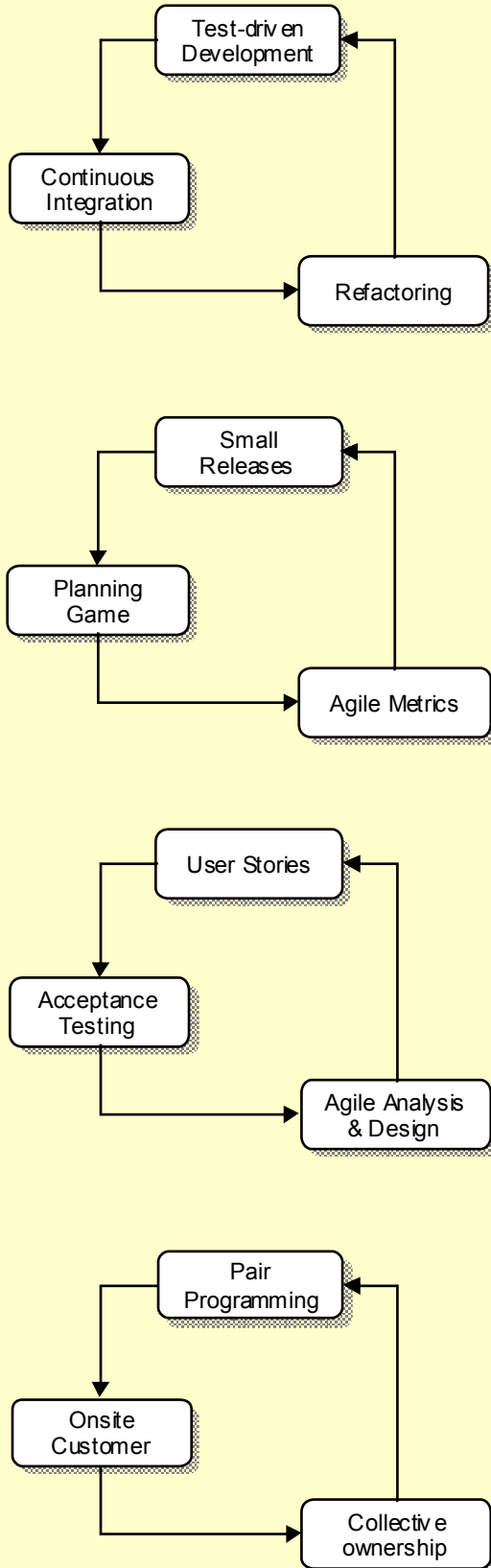

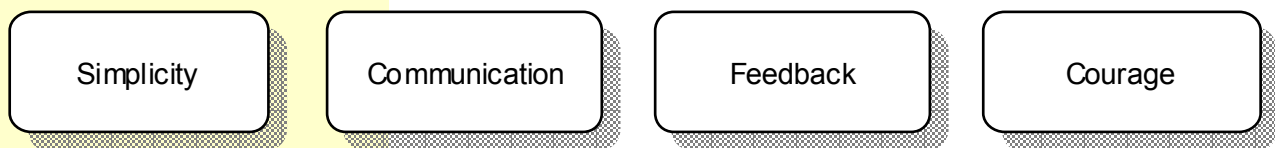

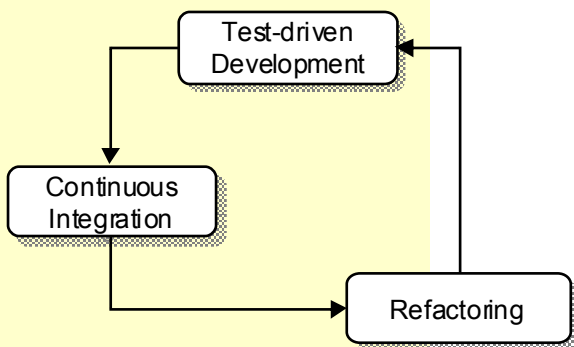


## What Will I Learn?

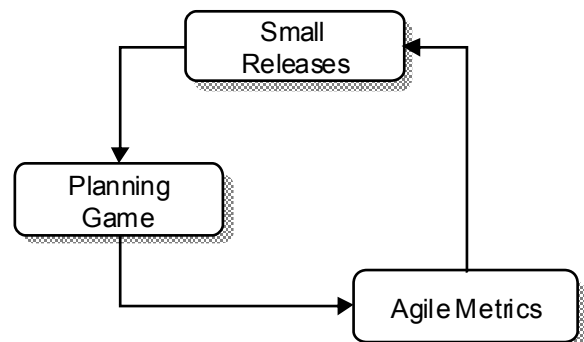

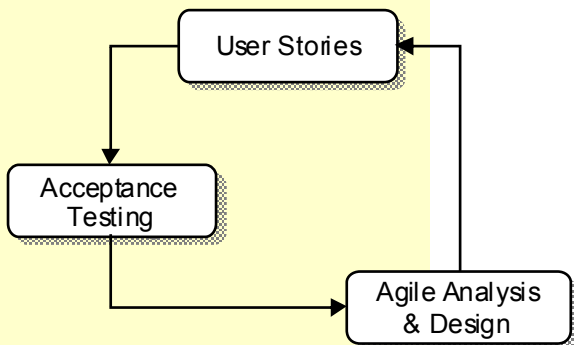

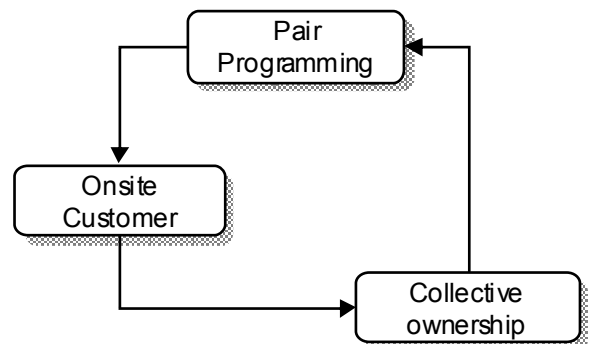
